## **Secretary of State Bruce McPherson Reminds Candidates and Committees of Filing Deadline**

SACRAMENTO, CA - Secretary of State Bruce McPherson issued a reminder today that tomorrow, Thursday, October 26, 2006 is a major campaign finance reporting deadline for state candidates, ballot measure committees, and other political organizations participating in the November 7, 2006 General Election.

For most campaign committees, the comprehensive reports will detail all contributions made and received, and all expenditures made between October 1 and October 21, 2006. Candidates and committees that raise or spend \$50,000 or more file their reports online with the Secretary of State. The deadline to submit the electronic filings is midnight Thursday night. They may be viewed immediately after submittal on the Secretary of State's Cal-Access web site: <a href="http://cal-access.ss.ca.gov">http://cal-access.ss.ca.gov</a>.

Filing reports will be candidates for statewide and legislative offices, ballot measure committees, political action committees, independent expenditure committees, slate mailer organizations, state and county political party committees, and major donors. The last pre-election reports were filed on October 5, and covered the period from July 1 through September 30, 2006. The new reports filed on Thursday will also present the committees' total contributions and expenditures from January 1 through October 21 of this year.

In the days remaining before Election Day, committees making and committees receiving contributions of \$1,000 or more will continue to disclose those payments in late contribution reports that are due within 24 hours of the transactions. Independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more also must be reported within 24 hours up until Election Day. The late reports also appear daily on Cal-Access.
