<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The processing times shown for the first and final day of the reporting period are snapshots in time. Processing times, in the form of business days, are tracked on a daily basis throughout the reporting period and from that information, the average processing time for the month is calculated. Throughout the month, the processing times fluctuate daily depending on the number of documents received each day (some days have higher volumes than others) and the number of documents processed.

Staff continue to work overtime to maintain the 5 business day average. We continue to prepare for the increased end of year filing workload. Peak season for Business Entities begins in December and continues through March. Statements of Information peak follows about 60 days later (typically February through May.
