Calif. Secretary of State Alex Padilla to Guest Lecture at UC San Diego Class on Voting Rights

- WHO:** California Secretary of State Alex Padilla will be speaking at UC San Diego at a class led by Nathan Fletcher, a former member of the California Assembly and current UCSD professor of practice in political science. At a time when many states are restricting access to voting rights, and when unsubstantiated allegations of voter fraud are being made at the federal level, California is aggressively moving to take action to increase voter participation.
