Secretary Padilla, LA County Registrar, Yvote and Student Volunteers to Urge Pre-registration at March for Our Lives

LOS ANGELES – California Secretary of State Alex Padilla is teaming up with the <u>Los</u> <u>Angeles County Registrar of Voters' office</u>, <u>Yvote</u>, and student volunteers to urge Angelenos participating in <u>March for Our Lives</u> to register and pre-register to vote.

Earlier this month, Secretary Padilla <u>announced that a total of 88,700 16- and 17-year-olds have</u> <u>pre-registered to vote in California</u> since the program launched in September 2016. Since that announcement, more than 3,000 California teens have completed pre-registration applications with the Secretary of State.

California's 16- and 17-year-olds can pre-register to vote online at <u>registertovote.ca.gov</u>. Their registration is activated when they turn 18.
