The Business Programs Division Filings Processing Budget Change Proposal was approved and incorporated into the Budget Act of 2020 (Chapter 6, Statutes of 2020). <sup>1</sup> The processing times shown for the first and final day of the reporting period are snapshots in time. Processing times, in the form of business days, are tracked on a daily basis throughout the reporting period and from that information, the average processing time for the month is calculated. Throughout the month, the processing times fluctuate daily depending on the number of documents received each day (some days have higher volumes than others) and the number of documents processed. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and orders to reduce staff in the office to less than 25%, the processing times remain above normal. We continue to focus on online services, registrations, and statements of information to continue to support the California economy. The online services are allowing some staff to telework.
